Covid Safe Plan for the Blackburn Football Club

At present Face Masks will not be required to be worn but all patrons should carry a mask with them in case they cannot socially distance.

A small supply of masks will be available if required.

The following Covid Safety Plan will cover the following.

- Signage throughout the Morton Park Sporting Complex.
- The Three entry Points to the Morton Park Complex
- What Patrons should expect when they wish to enter the Morton Park Grounds.
- What Patrons will be expected to do while within the Morton Park Sporting grounds.
- The Good Hygiene that they will see while within the Complex.
- And the New Club Rooms. The protocols that govern how things work within the new club rooms.

Signage and the Entry Locations to the Morton Park Ground

All entry points to the Morton Park Sporting ground will have signage indicating the following.

- That all patrons entering the Morton Park Sporting ground are required to check in via the provided QR Code or by signing the provided Covid sign in book.
- That while in the sporting complex they are required to socially distance where possible and practice good hand hygiene.
- ❖ There will be at all three Entry Points Automatic Sanitiser Machines.
- ❖ There will be a Sanitiser Machine @ the entrance to the new club rooms.
- That Sanitiser to support good hand hygiene is available throughout the complex, at the Canteen, The BBQ area, The 2 Can Bar areas. As well as the various areas of the new club rooms, such as the Entry Point to the new main area, the Kitchen, the Bar area, as well as the Change rooms and the Gym.

Entry Points to the Morton Park Sporting Ground

- There will be 3 Entry Points to Morton Park. Top Gate, Main Gate and the Glen Ebor entrances
- All entry points will be manned from 10.20am on Home Game Days till the Half time break.
- All entry points will have QR Codes for scanning as well as sign in books to gather contact information.
- Each Entry Point will have Automatic Sanitiser Stations for people to sanitise their Hands.
- Each entry Point will have signage that provides information on social distancing as well as other important information such as good Hand Hygiene.

QR Codes & The Covid Officers

- The QR Code signs will be placed throughout the grounds where needed such as all the Entry Points to the Sporting Grounds, the Canteen, the BBQ Area, the Can Bar Locations & in the New Club Rooms.
- We will have People in High Vis Vests roaming the grounds asking were needed for people to Socially Distance, & including the Covid Marshall who will have a High Vis Vest
- 4 Areas such as the Canteen, The BBQ area, and the Can Bar areas will have Sanitiser Available for people to sanitise their hands.
- Their will be a Sanitiser Station @ the Entry Point to the New Club Facility
- There will be 2 Covid Officers roaming the grounds during the games and requesting where needed that patrons social distance.

Hygiene in all areas @ Morton Park

- All areas within the Morton Park Complex such as the Canteen, the BBQ area, the Can Bar areas will practice good Hygiene.
- These areas will have the necessary cleaning materials such as Antibacterial sprays, Cleaning cloths as well as having the proper cleaning materials to maintain the Cleanliness of Kitchen, The Bar Area, the Main area to the New Rooms and other areas such as the Change rooms and the Gym.
- > All areas where food or drinks are consumed will be regularly cleaned to maintain good Hygiene.

Record keeping.

- Patrons entering the Morton Park area will be encouraged to check in via the QR Code or by signing in via the provided sign in book.
- These records will be kept and provided when required.

Volunteers

- ❖ All Volunteers will be shown this Covid Safe Plan to familiarise.
- Plus, there will be copies available and placed in all the areas of the Morton Park Complex.
